



Boulder Junction Winter Park Rules and Regulations

Welcome to Boulder Junction Winter Park! To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please follow these rules and guidelines during your visit:

1. **Emergency Assistance:** In case of an emergency, dial 911. First aid supplies are available at the warming hut.
2. **Park Hours:** The Winter Park is open daily from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM, weather permitting. Please respect these hours and exit the park promptly at closing time.
3. **Safety Gear:** Helmets are strongly recommended for all skaters, especially children. Proper winter attire, including gloves, is also encouraged to protect against the elements.
4. **Supervision:** Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult at all times. Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children.
5. **Wildlife** of all kinds share the park with us. Everybody, please use caution and all should be watchful. Instruct your children that they should be watchful also and not wander off alone.
6. **Skating Trail and Rink Use:**
 - Skate in a counterclockwise direction unless otherwise indicated.
 - Respect others by maintaining a safe distance and avoiding sudden stops or changes in direction.
 - No hockey sticks or pucks allowed on the skating trail.
 - Lighted hat or helmet is suggested for evening skating.
 - Skate in pairs or small groups for your safety.
7. **Prohibited Items:** The following are not allowed in the park:
 - Alcoholic beverages and illegal substances.
 - Smoking or vaping of any kind.
 - Glass containers or any items that may cause injury.
 - Fireworks.
8. **Respect Park Facilities:** Please respect all park features, including benches, signs, and landscaping. Damaging Park property, removing trees or vegetation, or littering will result in removal from the park and potential fines.



9. **Ice Maintenance:** Ice grooming and maintenance are performed regularly. Please stay off the ice when equipment is in use or when barriers are placed for maintenance purposes.
10. **No Roughhousing:** For the safety of all visitors, roughhousing, hockey games, and reckless behavior are not allowed on the skating trail or rink.
11. **Weather Conditions:** The park may close temporarily due to unsafe weather conditions. Please check local alerts or posted signs before visiting.
12. **Volunteer Respect:** Our Park is maintained by community volunteers. Please respect their instructions and thank them for their time and effort.
13. **Warming Hut:** Please keep the warming hut clean and tidy. Return all borrowed equipment to the warming hut after use.
14. **Snowshoeing:** Snowshoeing is allowed adjacent to the ice trail. Please stay off the skating trail to ensure the safety of all visitors.
15. **Fire Pit Use:** Fires are allowed only in the designated firepit area. Fire pit use is only allowed during periods when snow is on the ground.
16. **Camping and Motorized Vehicles:** No camping is allowed in the park. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on trails except for maintenance purposes.
17. **Parking:** Please diagonal parking only in designated parking areas. Parallel parking allowed on the northside of the Old K.
18. **Bathroom Facilities:** Bathroom facilities are provided for your convenience. Please respect them and keep them clean.
19. **Sledding Hill:**
 - Children must be supervised by an adult at all times while using the sledding hill.
 - Only one person per sled at a time unless the sled is designed for multiple riders.
 - Walk up the designated path to avoid collisions with those sledding down.
 - Helmets are strongly recommended for all sledders.
 - No building of jumps or other obstacles on the sledding hill.
 - Please be courteous and take turns to ensure everyone can enjoy the hill safely.
20. **Dogs** should be leashed and not allowed on the ice rink or directly on the skating trail. Please pick up after your dog while using the walking/snowshoe trail.
